

Subversive Beginnings

The first verse of


Genesis is classic and easy to memorize. But as with so many 'classic' bible verses, there is so much more happening underneath this story than we might realize.

At the time of the writing of Genesis, the Israelites would have been familiar with the creation stories of the surrounding cultures. One of which was The Epic of Gilgamesh, an ancient Sumerian poem where humans, and indeed the whole creation, were mistakenly created in chaos and rooted in the bloody violence between the god Marduk and goddess Tiamat.

Surrounded by these stories of violence and destruction, the author of Genesis sought to tell another story. Yahweh, the one true God, intentionally created humans and the entire universe to reflect his love and shalom. He created the world out of nothing, and it was all 'very good'.

This narrative went against the grain of the culture that the Israelites would have been all too familiar with in their Babylonian captivity and exile. It is in this story of subversive beginnings that we discover God created all of humanity not out of anger or violence, but out of a place of sacrificial and nurturing love..





Mothers describe falling in love with their babies and then, more slowly, learning to understand them. Children flourish when their mothers love and understand them. For over 20 years, Naomi Stadlen has listened to hundreds of mothers talking at her weekly discussion groups. In 'How Mothers Love' she offers unique insights into how mothers and babies learn to communicate intimately with one another.

When adults relate to one another, they are building on the foundations usually laid down by their mothers. 'How Mothers Love' is a study of how mothers start to build those foundations and covers areas such as: how to create emotional 'space' for your unborn child; how to maintain a close relationship with two or more children; the transformation into motherhood and your role as a mother in wider society.

By sharing the experiences of other mothers, Naomi Stadlen offers reassurance and support to all new parents as they navigate the highs and lows of the early years with their babies.



This week in history

1796 - Edward Jenner administered the first vaccination against smallpox.

1820 - English nurse Florence Nightingale, who founded trained nursing as a profession for women, was born in Florence, Italy; International Nurses Day is celebrated on her birthday

1885 - Louis Riel surrendered after leading two rebellions against the Canadian government in response to its efforts to assume the territorial rights of the Hudson's Bay Company in northwestern Canada.

1945 - World War II in Europe ended. Following Germany's unconditional surrender, in Europe officially ended at midnight on this day in 1945, although the war in the Pacific continued until the Japanese surrender in September.

Taste & See

Tuna and Cheddar Cornmeal Waffle Melt



Ingredients

2 x 300g tins MSC certified tuna
4 eggs
200g plain yogurt
65mL neutral oil (e.g., vegetable oil)
200g mature cheddar cheese, grated
120g spinach leaves
125g plain flour
125g cornmeal, coarse or fine polenta works well
2tsp baking powder
2tsp salt
2tsp sugar, you can use honey or maple syrup if you like
100g aioli/mayonnaise

Instructions

Step 1

Preheat the waffle maker.

Step 2

To make the waffle batter, combine the first 5 dry ingredients in a large bowl and set aside. In a smaller bowl, whisk eggs, yogurt and oil. Pour the wet ingredients into the dry and mix gently until just combined.

Step 3

To make the tuna mixture: Combine the tuna and aioli and set aside until you have prepared the waffles.

Step 4

To make the waffles: scoop a small amount of batter, around 75g onto the preheated waffle iron. Sprinkle a small amount of the tuna mixture over the batter, top generously with some grated cheese and a small handful of spinach leaves. Place another small scoop of batter on top (this time about 2 tablespoons).

Step 5

Cook until golden brown.

Step 6

Transfer cooked waffles to a cooling rack and serve warm.

Step 7

Can be cut in half for a fast casual snack to go, or served alongside some crunchy vegetables such as carrots, celery and baby tomatoes.
